



## Con Brio Accompanist Job Description

### Job Summary

Columbia Choirs has been an active arts organization in the Eastside community for over 40 years with choirs of all ages and skill levels. Con Brio is our adult treble choir and is led by one of our skilled conductors. We are seeking a part-time accompanist to help support Con Brio in their weekly rehearsals and in preparation for their seasonal concerts and various projects.

### Details

Position Type: Part time, non-exempt employee

Weekly hours: Typically 1.5, occasionally more as required by performances, retreats and outside performances.

Rehearsals: Con Brio meets weekly on Tuesdays between 7:30-9pm in Redmond, WA (Education Hill). The first rehearsal is September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

Extra events: Overnight Retreat at Dumas Bay Centre from October 10-11<sup>th</sup>, 2026; Performances will be December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 3pm, and June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2027 at 7pm. Other events may be scheduled throughout the year with advanced notice from the Artistic Director.

Reports to: Katrina Turman, Artistic Director

### Duties

- Accompany all rehearsals, performances, and retreats.
- Work collaboratively with the Con Brio conductor.
- Provide the Artistic Director with sufficient notice (typically at least two weeks) of any necessary absence so arrangements can be made for a substitute. The exception to the above would be in cases of emergency or illness.
- Intermittently attend agreed upon and scheduled meetings.

### Qualifications

- Advanced piano skills. Choral accompanying experience is highly preferred.
- Punctual and consistent attendance at all events.
- A cooperative attitude.
- A love for music and community singing.

### Compensation

Pay rate for rehearsals and concerts will be \$63 per hour. Pay rate for any administrative requirements (meetings, etc.) will be \$36 per hour.
